PROJECT PROFILE



This project consists of a two stories with a future balcony. The basement story, of approximately 3,800 SF, is used primarily as fellowship space. The main story, of approximately 5,200 SF, is dominated by a fixed pew sanctuary and includes offices and ancillary spaces. Site development included grading, parking, installation of a new septic system, and stormwater management design. The project began with a feasibility study to analyze the site regarding, zoning, grading, project area requirements and building orientation. We also provided the church with a preliminary construction budget which helped to guide them in decisions as to how to progress with their project.

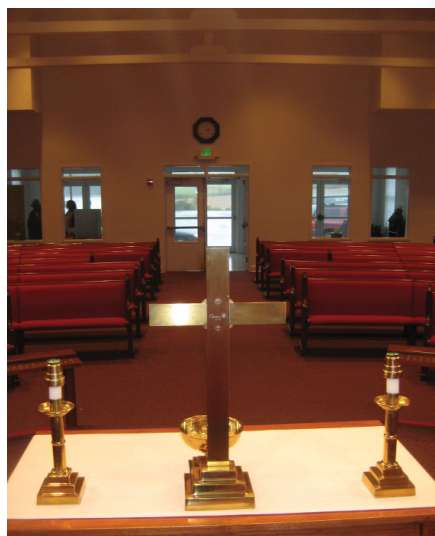
