

Deer Creek Friends Meeting House Darlington, Maryland

PROJECT PROFILE



The project at the Deer Creek Friends Meeting House is a 1,200 SF addition to a historic church building. This existing building is listed on the National Register of Historic Buildings. It is a simple, well-proportioned stone structure which was built in 1784. The addition is intended to be a wood frame construction with a painted clapboard exterior. This exterior is carefully detailed so that it complements the original building. The addition will serve as classrooms during the week, a meeting library, as well as a place for congregational fellowship and perhaps one day, a day care center. A semi-commercial kitchen is new to the historic structure. Moveable partitions are intended to be used to allow for this multipurpose arrangement.
