Father Martin's Ashley is a rehabilitation facility for the treatment of substance abuse. The complex is located on the Chesapeake Bay in a peaceful area of Harford County. While designing this building it was important that we kept in mind the architecture of the existing historic structure, also a part of the facility. The new building, which is a classical design, complements the existing building and extends the tranquil setting of the area while providing the many spaces necessary to run a rehabilitation facility. The existing classically designed structure, once home to the Tydings family, was constructed of Port Deposit Granite. The new building mirrored the classical design elements used in the existing building and was kept to the same visual scale with the house, although its square footage is quite immense.
