PROJECT PROFILE

The Havre de Grace Activity Center is designed to serve several different user groups by accommodating a wide variety of functions. This single story, 30,000 square foot facility is administered and utilized by Harford County Department of Parks and Recreation, but it also houses a Boys and Girls Club and an outreach of the Harford County Office on Aging.



Each user has a separate entrance and dedicated spaces, but each shares common spaces as well. The Activity Center contains office space for each user, as well as classrooms, a billiard room, an exercise room, a multi-purpose dining facility, and a high-school sized gymnasium.

The exterior of the building is designed with mansard roofs and a color scheme intended to refer to the Victorian architecture characteristic of downtown Havre de Grace. Brick banding in the elevations relates to the brick of the adjacent Havre de Grace Middle School building.
